

Internship and Scholarly Project Requirement for Dual Majors

MPH students pursuing a dual major must complete the 45 credits (cr.) of core (24 cr.), major (12 cr.), and elective (9 cr.) courses for their designated first major plus, for their second major, 21 credits (cr.) of major (12 cr.) and elective (9 cr.) courses for a 66 credit total.

Provided that dual major students have completed at least one internship or one scholarly project associated with the core of one of the two majors, some discretion can be used via electives for the second major regarding the requirement for a second internship or second scholarly project. For example, students wishing to complete a second internship, second scholarly project, or a combination may apply those credits toward the required elective credits for the second major, pending approval by the Major Coordinator. Alternatively, a second internship or scholarly project may not be required for the second major, depending on the nature/topic of the internship or scholarly project completed for students' designated first major and pending approval by the Major Coordinator.
